



Sixth Form Dress Code & Equipment

Our Sixth Form dress code is smart business dress and we expect all Year 12 and 13 students to meet the professional business wear expectations as follows:

Boys' Dress Code

Jacket and trousers	Business suit or blazer and tailored trousers (students are expected to wear a jacket when moving around the site and in the dining hall). No denim materials.
Shirt	Collared with tie.
Jumper	A plain pullover, may be worn under a blazer but shirt and tie should be visible. Hoodies and sweatshirts are not acceptable.
Shoes	Smart, practical, clean shoes (no trainers or casual footwear).

Girls' Dress Code

Business suit	Trousers, skirt or dress suit – the skirt/dress should sit on or just above the knee (students are expected to wear a jacket when moving around the site and in the dining hall). No denim materials or leggings/jeggings.
Tops	Shirt, blouse or smart top (no cropped, low cut, strappy tops, t-shirts or translucent clothing).
Jumper	A plain pullover. Hoodies and sweatshirts are not acceptable.
Shoes	Smart, practical, clean shoes (no trainers or casual footwear e.g. Ugg-style boots, flimsy pumps, canvas shoes, backless shoes, stilettos).

Appearance

Hair should be tidy at all times and of a natural style and colour. It should not be of an exaggerated nature, unnaturally dyed or bleached. There should be no excessive application of hair products. Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back in practical and Science lessons. No facial piercings are acceptable and there must be no visible tattoos. For boys, facial hair is acceptable, providing it is neat and tidy.

These guidelines may be relaxed for special events e.g. trips or non-uniform days. However, shorts and low cut/cropped tops are not appropriate. In extreme weather, students should continue to dress appropriately for a professional environment, but further guidelines will be issued appropriate to the weather conditions, for example excessively cold or hot spells.

Students who dress inappropriately will be required to attend a uniform check with the Deputy Head Pastoral and reminded of the guidelines. Students who fail to comply with these guidelines may be asked to return home to change into something more suitable. If students or their parents have any doubt as to whether an item of clothing is suitable for school, they should consult the Director of Sixth Form.

Equipment & Stationery

All pupils are issued with an iPad (Gen6 to Gen8) to use during their time at Embley. Please provide an iPad compatible stylus and a set of earphones. Though the iPad remains the property of the school, a pupil will be able to take it home and operate it as if it were his/her own.

Sixth Form Sports Kit

Embley's uniform is supplied by Schoolblazer (www.schoolblazer.com). Uniform can be purchased from the supplier's website. Embley Parents' Association run a second-hand uniform shop which is located by the Senior School car park. Please check the Embley School Portal for the latest opening times. Schoolblazer provides nametag application free of charge. Items marked with * can only be bought from Schoolblazer.

Students who are selected to represent the school at fixtures will be required to buy the team (Games) kit for the relevant sport. Our Sport's Department will provide guidance on this when the additional kit is required.
